

## Working walls and the classroom environments support and promote key aspects of learning.




We use DB Primary as a safe learning platform. E-safety, alongside other safety measures are regular so that children know how to keep safe.






Everyone participates in learning, through effective talk partners, teaching and learning strategies, routines and habits.








Trips, visiting guests and role play enhance learning with children and staff immersed in learning and those wow moments. Dressing up and taking on roles, bringing learning alive.






#### We have a love of reading, valuing story time and reading every day.
