

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Early Years staff are continuing to develop our outdoor area, making this a purposeful learning space from the very start to the end of each day. In order for us to do this we need to make a few changes in how we access the classrooms.

Therefore, after the half term holiday we will be requiring all parents and children to wait on the playgrounds nearest their classrooms instead of coming into the Early Years outdoor leaning area, both before and after school. Families for Albatross Class please stand alongside the fence next to our beach huts.

Staff will open the gates to welcome the children and see them into their classrooms. Members of staff will always be available to discuss any messages for the day. At the end of the day, children will wait in the classrooms until staff see their parents and carers, then will release the child to the member of staff at the gate to hand over safely into your care.

This system is already in place and runs smoothly for our Nursery families.

Siblings of Nursery children who wish to will of course be welcome to take the younger children into Tiddlers classroom, but will be expected to stay with their parents.
