What is Maths with Parents?

Maths with Parents is an online platform linked to the methods and resources used within our maths curriculum at school. This online platform will allow you and your child to watch short videos explaining maths topics your teacher chooses, complete set activities or play games linked to the video content. Your class teacher can then receive feedback from you and see how your child is getting on. We look forward to seeing you sign up. Read on to find out how.

To Sign Up

- 1) Visit <http://www.mathswithparents.com>
- 2) Click the Enter Site button, then the New Parent button
- 3) Enter details about you and your child and click Confirm
- 4) Enter your child's 6-digit class code (once you have registered, you will not need this again!)

You have Signed Up – what next?

- Use your password to login (your username is your email address; your password will be emailed to you)
- Watch the introductory video to see how it works
- Then watch the video for the first topic with your child and choose the activity to play first
- After you have played the activity together, leave feedback for the teacher or upload a photo. This is really important, so they know how your child is getting on
- Pick an item to dress up your Mathscot!

You will be notified every time a new topic has been set by your teacher.
