Dear Parent / Carers,

I hope you and your families are all keeping well and thank you as always for your continued patience and support.

As you will have heard yesterday on the news, the current lockdown measures are still in place with some alterations.

The Prime Minister announced that after half term – **1<sup>st</sup> June at the earliest** – a phased return to school **may** begin in stages for children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6, if infections rates at the time allow it.

I am sure that this has raised lots of questions, however, we are awaiting further guidance from the Government and education unions. The leaders of the school will continue to plan for the next stage and will provide parents / carers with an update in readiness.

During this time, the school will continue to remain closed for the majority of children and we are only open for 'vulnerable' children and the children of critical key workers where their attendance at our childcare provision is essential, as the child is unable to remain safely at home.

We are continuing to provide remote learning via DB primary and information shared on our website, we will also continue to post videos, songs and stories on our social media pages to share with your children.

I will continue to keep you informed of any further information in the coming days and weeks once I am able to do so. Once again I would like to wish you and your families to stay safe and well.
