- In EYFS there is no difference between PP and NPP with there being a 1% difference in favour of PP ٠
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- In Phonics not PP children outperformed PP children by 3% the same margin as last year. In Year 2 the PP children outperformed the non PP children in reading and maths and were 6% away in writing. •
- In Year 2 PP children increased the percentage achieving ARE in Reading and maths and were 8% dwdy in writing.
 In Year 2 PP children increased the percentage achieving ARE in Reading by 25%, in writing by 17%, reducing the gap between PP and non PP by 24% and in maths by 34%.
 The percentage of year 2 children achieving ARE fell in reading and writing, but even taking this into account the PP children would have beaten the non PP children's 2016 achievements in reading and maths
 In Year 6 the PP children outperformed the non PP in writing, combined maths and English scores and in GPS. They were 1%
- away from outperforming the non PP in Reading and 4% in maths. In Year 6 the PP children increased the percentage achieving ARE in Reading by 34%, in writing by 8%, in maths by 25%, combined maths and English by 47% and in GPS by 26% •
