



Dear Parents and Carers,

In Religious Education, Year 3 have been learning about special books and why they are important to different religions. We have arranged for the children to visit the Westcliff synagogue in Finchley Road on Wednesday 13th February to see the Torah, which is a very important book to the Jewish people. There will be an opportunity to explore the synagogue and pose questions to a member of the Jewish community. We will be travelling to and from the synagogue by coach during the school day.

Seashell Class and Rockpool Class will be going to the synagogue in the morning and will return to school before lunchtime. Pebble Class and Dune Class will be going in the afternoon, after they have eaten lunch at school, and will return to school ready for collection at 3:30pm. The synagogue has asked that all boys please cover their heads whilst entering the synagogue, as a sign of respect. The children can wear a hat/cap from home.

The cost of the trip is £3.50 per child, to be paid via your ParentPay account. Please let your child's class teacher know if you would like to help on the trip.
