city	Settlement of a substantive size. Southend is a city.
coastal	an area of land close to the sea
State (USA)	A territory with its own population and institutions. A sovereign state has governance.
equator	a line dividing the earth into northern and southern hemispheres and constituting the parallel of latitude 0°.
human features	Features that have been created or modified by humans in an environment
immigration	the action of coming to live permanently in a foreign country.
latitude	the angular distance of a place north or south of the earth's equator.
longitude	the angular distance of a place east or west of the Greenwich meridian.
migration	movement of people to a new area or country in order to find work or better living conditions.
physical features	Natural features on the earth's landscape: terrains, landforms, bodies of water
port	Harbour for vessels to moor or load and unload cargo
rural	places that are far away from large towns or cities
