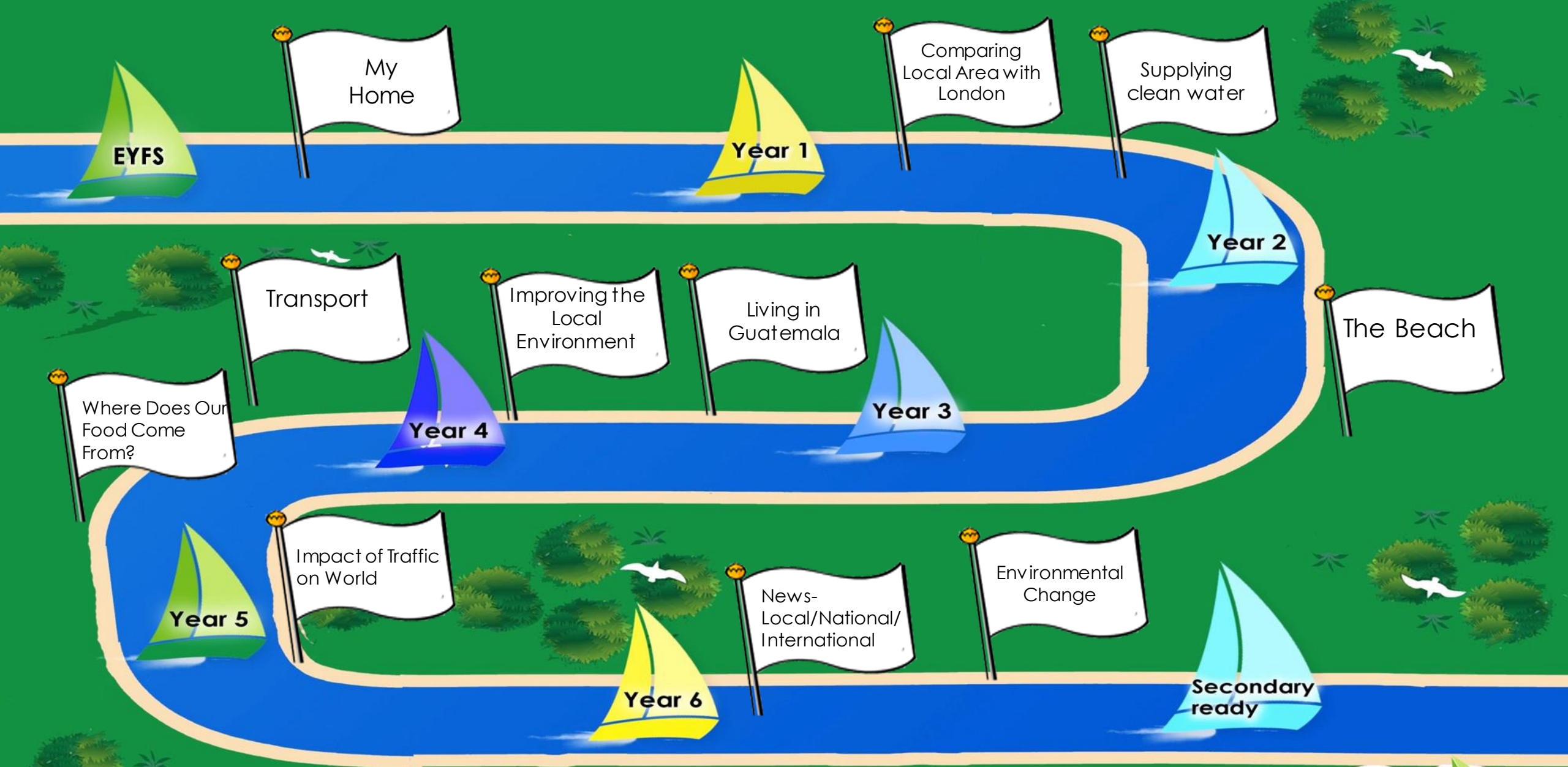
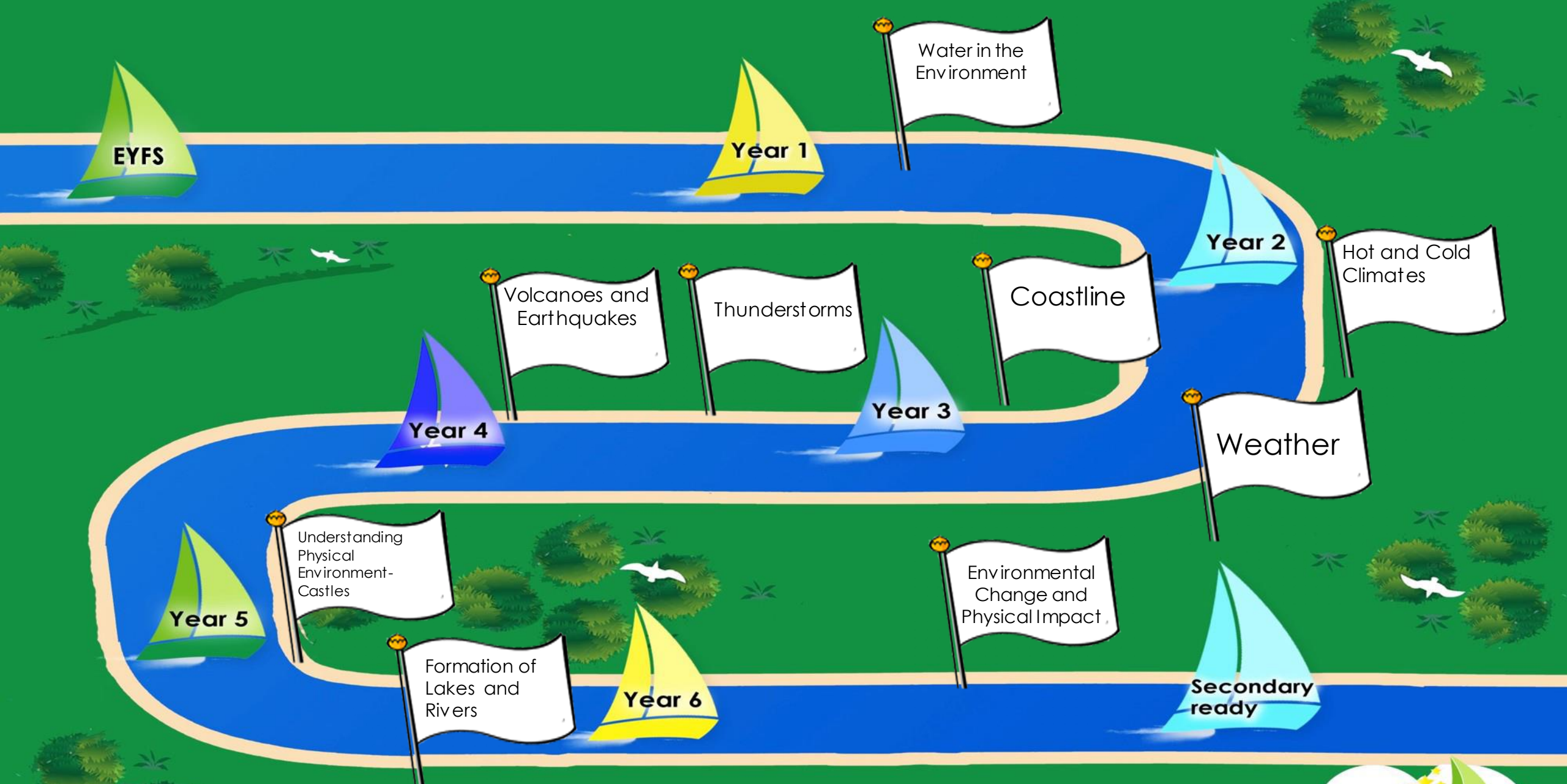


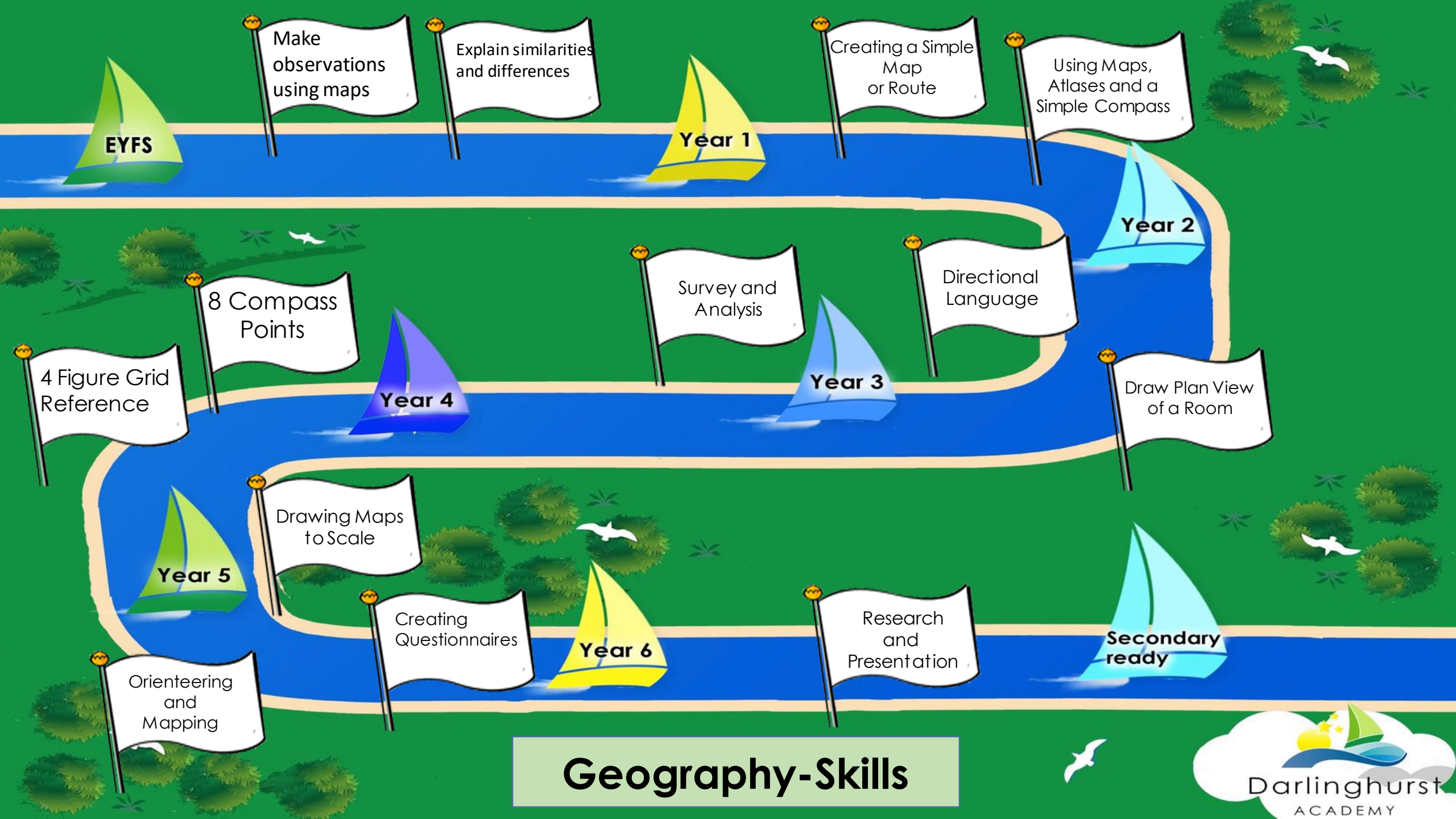
Geography- Location curriculum map
