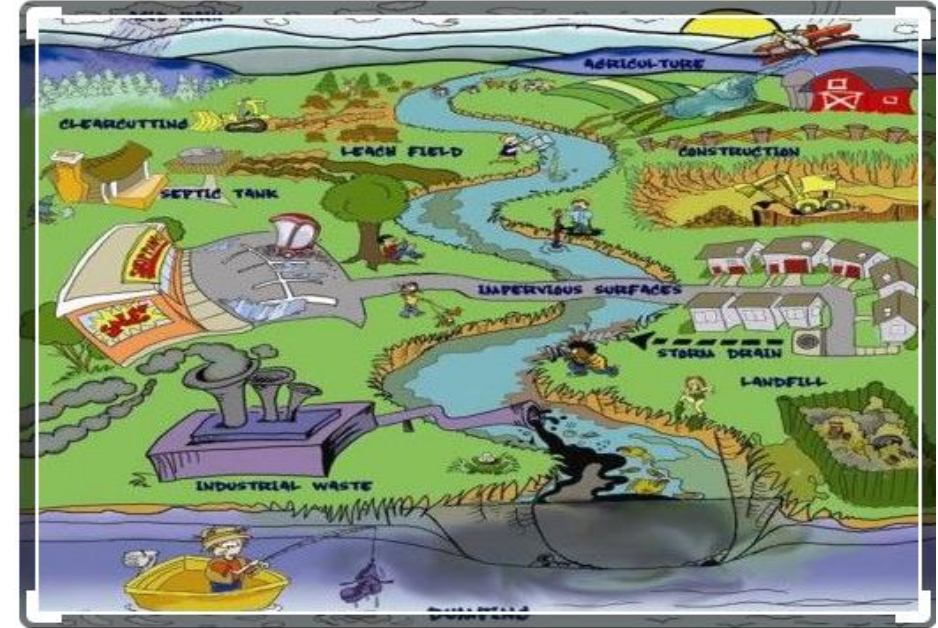
## Forms of pollution

Vocabulary	
<b>local</b>	relating to a particular area or one's neighbourhood.
<b>national</b>	relating to or characteristic of a nation; common to a whole nation.
<b>international</b>	existing, occurring, or carried on between nations
<b>environment</b>	the surroundings or conditions in which a person, animal, or plant lives or operates.
<b>population</b>	all the inhabitants of a particular place.
<b>pollution</b>	the presence in or introduction into the environment of a substance which has harmful or poisonous effects.
<b>recycle</b>	convert (waste) into reusable material.
<b>transport</b>	take or carry (people or goods) from one place to another by means of a vehicle, aircraft, or ship.
<b>sustainable</b>	conserving an ecological balance by avoiding depletion of natural resources.

Solar panels turn the **energy** from sunshine into electricity.

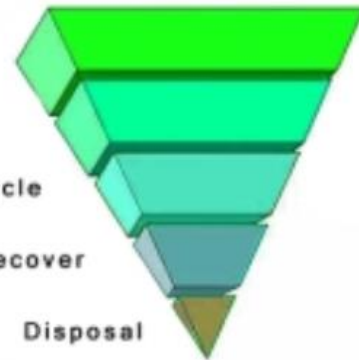


The **energy** from heat deep underground can be turned into electricity. This is geothermal **energy**.
