the nursery children have entered happily and equally the excitement they show when they see their parents at the end of their session.



attitudes of their groups, including their approach to on line learning. Regardless of the changing weather patterns, the children enjoyed their activities inside and


out, including some singing and dancing. Mrs Hahn said, "I am so proud of the children and teachers in blue zone for showing their positive attitude and team spirit.


