These subject include wildlife adventures, an amazing range of sports activities and fantastic art opportunities which allow our creativity to grow. The field eve has a 200 metre running rack for running and keeping healthy.

Finally, our school values, we have A for Achievement, B is for Belonging, C for Confidence, D for Determination and E for Excellence. Whenever any child in the school shows any one of these values, they will be sent a postcard home in celebration. We love receiving these through our letterboxes!

It has been an honour telling you about the school I love and I hope I will see you at some point this evening.

As you heard from Max we have some fantastic facilities in our school such as the Anchor room. The Anchor room is a place we can go to, to talk about worries and get help, comfort and support. The staff there also help us focus on positive thoughts.

Max has already mentioned our values and I want to talk about belonging further. We always work together at Darlinghurst. Our house HMS Vincent, Rayleigh, Ganges and Dolphin bring us all together as we earn points for exceptional work, showing our school values, kindness and sports day. Sport day is a great day earning lots of points for your house.

I really hope that you see how amazing our classrooms and grounds are and why we love this school so much. Don't forget to ask lots of questions and have a great time on your tour. Thank you for coming.

Thank you, I am sure you will agree that not only did they demonstrate our value of 'confidence' but also achieved, 'Excellence together'.

We know that success is not measured by academic outcomes alone. We celebrate achievements big and small, the triumphs that our children have and those moments that build character and personal success. I am sure you will agree that Max and Jemima's speech was one of these moments.

However, our results reflect the quality of education that we provide, with our children making positive progress from their starting points across the curriculum

with progress in reading, writing and maths, above national averages. This shows the support and challenged given to our children, to reach their potential. Here at Darlinghurst we value the importance of reading and phonics, with phonic outcomes that surpass national with published results at 96%. By the time our children leave the academy, they are fully prepared for their next stage. This is reflected in their knowledge and skills across the wider curriculum but in their outcomes in reading, writing and maths – which are above national.

I would like to now like to welcome to the stage two students who we have witnessed thrive during their time at Darlinghurst. Both examples of children who embraced academy life and fully engaged in the wider curriculum, preparing them for secondary school. Thank you for taking the time to come back and share your reflections with us.

Thank you both again for coming along this evening and for your contributions past and present. I wish you continued success and happiness at secondary school and beyond.

Our staff, from the moment our children join us, support them to become resilient, capable and confident children. They focus on building relationships, which allows our children to happily settle. Our Early Years provision within 'the Rockpool' is an engaging and purposeful place to explore, discover and create. We provide a careful balance of adult-led and child initiated learning. The Early Years team are skilled in observing and interacting in purposeful play, maximising every learning opportunity. Our Nursery children in 'Tiddlers' and our Reception 'Jellyfish' and 'Starfish', love their time there.
