They help us to feel **green** and **safe**

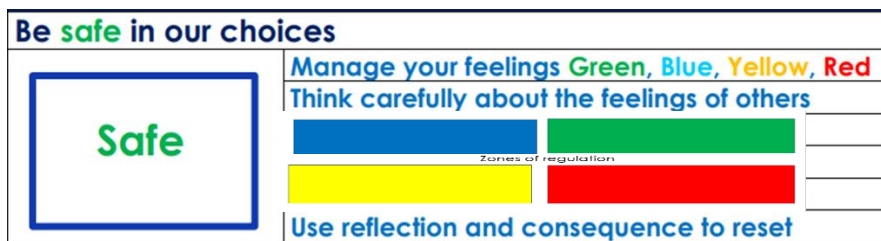
Children, parents and trusted adults work together to **S.T.O.P** bullying.
